Affiliate Membership

Affiliate membership will be open to people external to the profession of Prosthetics and Orthotics who either work within the field of prosthetics and/or orthotics or who have a special interest in the field.

There are two categories of affiliate membership. These are:

- **Professional**
Any other health professional working within the fields of prosthetics and/or orthotics would be eligible for this class of affiliation; such as bioengineer, doctor, nurse or allied health professional. They must provide evidence in the form of a copy of their HPC/NMC/GMC (or other UK regulatory body) certificate of registration. They should also supply a supporting letter from a BAPO full member.
- **Individual**
Any individual with an interest in the prosthetic and orthotic profession would be eligible for this class of affiliation, subject to BAPO receiving letters of support from two full members of the Association, at the time of application. The application should set out and explain the individual's link to Prosthetics and/or Orthotics and their areas of interest.
