## **Membership Qualification**

Membership is only open to those qualified as an Orthotist, Prosthetist or Prosthetist/Orthotist. Those who qualify for BAPO membership but who are no longer employed within the Prosthetic and Orthotic Profession in any capacity are eligible for non-practising member status.

The recognised routes to qualification are:

### **UK Qualified Route**

- B.Sc. (Hons.) Prosthetics and Orthotics (University of Strathclyde).
- B.Sc. (Hons) Prosthetics and Orthotics (University of Salford)
- Diploma in Orthotics – awarded by the Orthotists Training Council prior to 1982.
- Diploma in Prosthetics awarded by Paddington Technical College – prior to 1982.
- OPTEC Diploma in either Orthotics or Prosthetics.
- Higher Diploma Prosthetics/Orthotics (SCOTEC/University of Strathclyde) with evidence of completed internship in prosthetics and/or orthotics.

Applicants with UK qualifications gained prior to 1985 may be admitted only on the approval of our Executive Committee.

### **Non - UK Qualified Route**

Prosthetists and Orthotists who have qualified outside the UK wishing to join BAPO submit evidence of the following:

- Recognised Prosthetic and/or Orthotic qualification from own country **and**
- Health Professions Council registration (this is required as to use the title prosthetist/orthotist, prosthetist or orthotist in the UK you must be registered with the Health Professions Council)
