

## **Opportunities for doctoral research in allied health practice and service delivery**

City University, London's Department of Radiography and Centre for Allied Health Professions Research are offering opportunities to pursue doctoral-level research into allied health practice and service delivery issues. Our four-year, part-time doctoral programme is aimed at senior professionals, educated to Masters level and with an interest in advancing practice. Financial support is available in the form of a limited number of fees-only bursaries.

Research will focus on AHP practice, service delivery or organisation in areas such as:

- service planning, design and redesign
- improving access
- new professional roles and ways of working
- management and leadership development
- workforce planning and modernisation
- research capacity and the evidence base for services

Research projects should have an interprofessional focus which includes radiography as a significant element. It is therefore likely that successful applicants will come from a radiography background, although we also welcome applications from professionals in other disciplines.

This programme represents an outstanding opportunity for in-depth professional development, together with formal recognition in the form of a doctoral degree. It will help you to develop advanced research skills and knowledge, and to pursue original lines of research of direct relevance to your work.
